## Finance Bulletin No. 1

The Department and many Units have the fiscal year end of September 30. What this means is that budgeting and financial statements should be developed for the period of October 1 through September 30.

Unless otherwise indicated, contributions and remittances through Department Headquarters must be remitted by September 30 to be included for the fiscal year ending that date. So, what does that mean? If you held a Poppy Day and generated funds, your Poppy Percentage should be remitted to Department Headquarters by September 30. How do you calculate this amount to remit...

### **Amount of Donations (and other Poppy Income)**

**Less: Cost of Poppies**

**Net Income from Poppy Program**

**Multiply by .30**

**Equals Poppy Percentage to Department**

It is extremely important that Units participate in the Poppy Program and remit the Poppy Percentage to the Department. VA&R Assessments and the Poppy Percentage are the funding mechanism for the two VAMC programs, the three state veterans' homes, and the additional veterans' programs from the Department.

Speaking of the VA&R Assessment, this amount is due by December 31 to qualify for awards at Winter Conference. These assessments must be paid before Spring Conference and Department Convention to be eligible for awards. These assessments are based on \$15 plus 15 cents per senior member and the amount for each Unit is listed on the reverse of this bulletin.

Effective July 1, 2018 nonprofit organizations are required to collect and remit sales tax to the Kentucky Department of Revenue. Many Units do not have sales tax numbers and must apply for them. Please go to: <https://revenue.ky.gov/Forms/10A100.pdf> for the instructions and application form for a Kentucky Sales Tax Number. Units will be required to collect and remit sales tax on "admissions," which includes tickets to charitable fundraising events, gym membership fees, facility rental fees, and entry fees for charity tournaments. Nonprofits will also be required to collect and remit sales tax on items it sells at events and charitable auctions. I have been in contact with the Department of Revenue and learned that we do not have to remit sales tax on membership dues or in conjunction with Department conferences or convention.
